



Captains who employ or contract workers on a fishing vessel have responsibilities under the *Occupational Health and Safety Act*.

Do you know your health and safety responsibilities?

- **Provide** a safe and healthy workplace. A fishing vessel is considered a workplace
- **Ensure** that workers receive safety information, instruction, training and supervision
- **Ensure** that equipment is guarded and that tools and personal protective equipment are properly used and maintained to protect workers
- **Support** safety activities and **cooperate** with safety officials
- **Report** serious incidents by calling the 24/7 Occupational Health and Safety Emergency Line at 902-628-7513
- Conduct hazard assessments and prevent exposing workers to hazards
